THE GRANTORS The Trustees of the Bluford Missionary Baptist Church of the Bluford in the County of Jefferson and State of Illinois for and in consideration of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars, in hand paid CONVEY AND QUIT CLAIM to The Trustees of the Laird Missionary Baptist Church of the Belle Rive County of Jefferson and State of Illinois all interest in the following described Real Estate, to wit:

Commencing at the North West corner of the North West fourth of the South East quarter of Section Thirteen (13) and then runs due South about Twenty rods, so as to join on to the land deed to the Laird Cemetery or its Trustees by Jacob Shrum, and thence due East with the North line of the said cemetery from rods and thence to run due North about twenty rods and thence due West four rods to the place of beginning so as to contain one half acre lying along on the East side of the Public road and north of the West end of the Laird Cemetery all in Township three (3) South Range Four (4) East of the 3rd P.M. in Jefferson County, Illinois

situated in the County of Jefferson, in the State of Illinois, hereby releasing and waiving all rights under and by virtue of

the Homestead Exemption Laws of this State. Whenever this building ceases to be used as a Missionary Baptist Church it will revert back to the Bluford Missionary Baptist Church at Bluford, Illinois.
